• English Language Learners (21%): Recognizing the linguistic diversity within our community, we embrace and celebrate the unique cultural perspectives of English Language Learners. Our programs offer targeted language support and culturally responsive activities to enhance language proficiency.

Students in Temporary Housing (22%): For the 22% of our students experiencing temporary

housing situations, we provide a stable and nurturing after-school environment. We understand the importance of consistency in their education and strive to create a sense of belonging and security.
Chronically Absent Students (25%): Addressing the challenge of chronic absenteeism, we work diligently to create engaging and meaningful learning experiences that encourage

regular attendance. Our goal is to instill a love for learning that transcends any obstacles




