RESPONSIBILITIES

The part-time Program Leader, under the direction of the Site Coordinator, is responsible for the daily implementation of the After-School All-Stars program model:

Youth Supervision:

- Provide safe and supervised activities for student participants
- Teaching responsibilities require your presence on campus for required times
- Using the ASAS approach of positive youth discipline, help students take ownership of their actions and grow from consequences of such actions
- Provide a healthy snack to students

Facilitation:

Work in conjunction with the Site Coordinator and fellow Program Leaders to ensure that
program activities are exciting and relevant to youth, as well as organized and well-thought out

- Support ongoing student recruitment and promotion of the program
- Maintain a strong connection with students to better understand their interests so as to plan and offer activities that keep them engaged throughout your session
