**After-School All-Stars** is one of the country's largest nonprofit organizations working to close the opportunity gap for low-income youth. We provide year-round free, comprehensive afterschool programs and support services for students and their families.

Comprised of 19 chapters, ASAS programs are currently operating at 725 school-year sites and summer camps in 78 cities across the country. Last year, our programs served 118,068 students living in high-poverty communities. 91% of ASAS students are youth of color and 90% qualify for the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program.

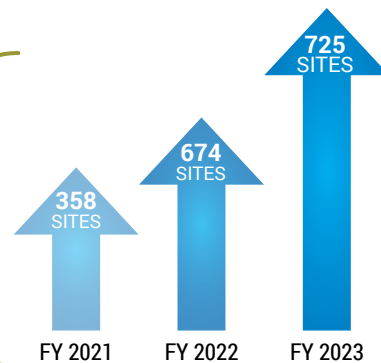

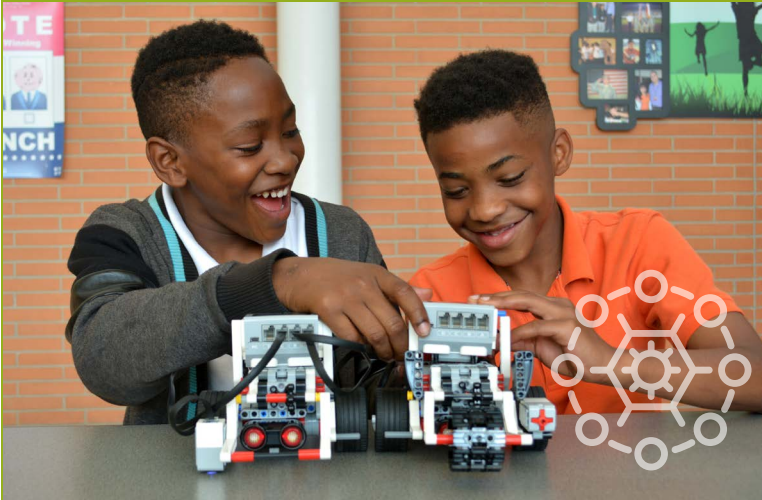
MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT

## CAREER EXPLORATION

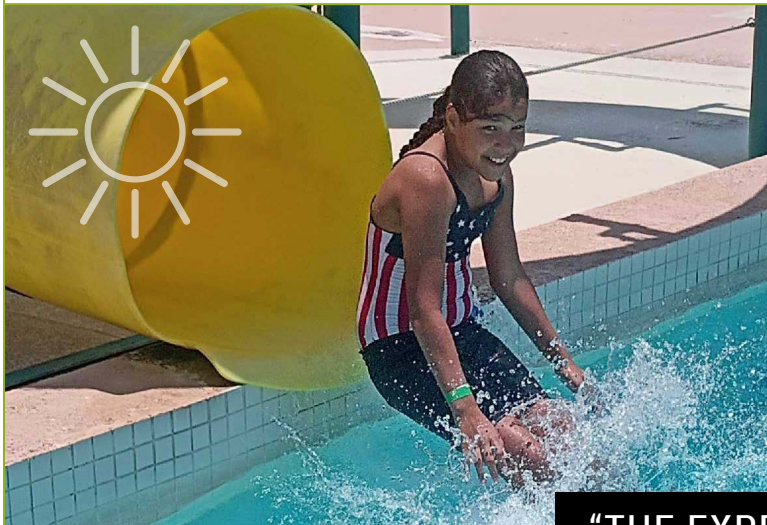
Career exploration programs expose our students to career pathways and industry mentors. Students develop strategies for exploring career and education goals, while building skillsets for the modern work environment.
