<u>ASAS Philadelphia & Camden</u> provides high quality after-school programming for students grades kindergarten through 8th grade at 11 sites in Philadelphia and Camden. We deliver comprehensive, community-based programs to students attending under-resourced schools in five program areas: Health and Wellness; Academic Readiness; STEM Programming; Career Exploration; and Visual and Performing Arts.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITES

Specific duties will include prospect research of new donors and community partners, helping to create a marketing & outreach list to help promote the ASAS Philadelphia & Camden chapter and help to plan and execute a volunteer and donor engagement event.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

ASAS is seeking a self-motivated candidate with excellent communication and organizational skills and a particular interest in the fields of youth development, education, and/or community outreach. A successful candidate will also embody ASAS' core values: entrepreneurial, proactive, transparent, collaborative, and accountable.

- Ability to communicate effectively and demonstrate sensitivity to others.
- Familiarity and experience with diverse populations, culture competencies, and youth principles are strongly desired.
- Must clear FBI and BCI checks.
- Must meet <u>AmeriCorps' eligibility criteria</u>: "hold one of the following citizenship or legal residency statuses: US citizen, US National, Lawful Permanent Resident (i.e. Green Card status), and persons legally residing within a state."

BENEFITS

VISTA members receive the following <u>benefits set by AmeriCorps</u>: a modest annual living allowance of about \$22,800, healthcare benefit, and childcare assistance, if eligible. After successful service year completion, the VISTA member also receives non-competitive eligibility for federal positions and a choice between a Segal Education Award (valued at approximately \$6,895) or a \$1,800 cash stipend. In addition, After-School All-Stars will also provide a \$100/month grocery stipend.
